The Jeffersonville Parks and Recreation would like to invite all kids that will be entering grades 2-8 to our exciting 2010 All Sports Camp, which will run from Monday, July 26-Friday, July 30 and include instruction in many different sports. We are very excited to promote this camp with the help of numerous coaches from Jeffersonville High School that will instruct our youth during this week long event. This truly is an opportunity for each participant to learn something new about a sport that they may never have participated in before. Our goal is for each individual to have a fun and enjoyable time while learning some of the key fundamentals and mechanics of each sport that they participate in.

The setup for this camp will include two sessions per day, which will allow the kids to learn different sports per session. Session one each day will run from 9am-12pm and session two will run from 1pm-4pm. Between each session, a small lunch will be provided each day. The sport sessions will take place Monday-Thursday. On Friday, each participant will enjoy the day at the Jeffersonville Aquatic Center for a morning of excitement in the pool. Pizza will be offered during this timeframe. The camp will officially conclude at 12pm (noon) on Friday and all participants are to be picked up at the Aquatic Center at that time.

The cost for this week long event is \$50 per individual, which will include a 2010 All Sports Camp t-shirt.
